Board Position You Are Applying For: Secretary

Please describe the responsibilities of the position you are seeking.:

Before the season starts, I would create each divisions Google doc and share with all qualified umpires for them to sign up for games. I would work with D5 to coordinate umpire clinics.

I would ensure appropriate gear is available at the snack bar for all Junior Umpires.

Lastly, I would make it a point to study league bylaws and little league rules to ensure accuracy.

What skills and abilities do you bring with you to perform in this position?:

Mostly my passion for the game would lead in my ability to succeed in this role. My many years of coaching has polished my rulebook knowledge.

I have umpired many games for FOV and wouldn't hesitate to gear up.

Give an example of something you have done to improve or make FOVLL a better place.:

Please describe the responsibilities of the position you are seeking.:

Board Position You Are Applying For: Treasurer

If running for Treasurer, tell us about your Quickbook experience?:

I have several years of hands-on experience using QuickBooks as the Treasurer for the Sacramento chapter of National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC), where I manage all financials for the nonprofit organization. I also use QuickBooks for personal financial management and am very comfortable navigating the system, generating reports, reconciling accounts, and maintaining accurate records.

Why do you want to take on this position?:

I care deeply about the long-term success of FOVLL and the experience it provides for the local kiddos and families. As a parent of two young boys who will be part of this league for many years, I'm invested in making sure it continues to be a fun, positive, safe, and well-run environment.

Over the past year on the auxiliary board, I've had the opportunity to learn how the league operates — what's working well and where there may be opportunities to improve. I would focus on strengthening both the operational side of the league and the overall experience for families. From a Treasurer perspective, that includes bringing consistency, organization, and transparency to financial processes, so the board and all families have a clear and reliable understanding of how resources are being used. Beyond that, I care about improving the experience for players and families at every level — especially in the younger divisions where many families are new to the league. That includes clearer and more consistent communication, supporting coaches with training and resources, and ensuring strong safety practices are in place. I would also love to support long-term improvements to the facilities, such as shade structures, bleachers, lighting, and other field enhancements that make the environment more comfortable and accessible for families and allow for expanded field use.

Most importantly, I want to help create an environment where kids are having fun, developing skills, building confidence, making friendships, and being surrounded by positive role models. That's what makes Little League special, and I want to help strengthen that experience for everyone involved.

What do you hope to achieve as a member of the FOVLL Board?:

I hope to contribute to a well-organized, transparent, and collaborative organization that supports both the league and the broader community.

I also believe it's important to bring a variety of perspectives to the board. As a parent of younger players and as a mom, I can help represent the experience of families who are newer to the league — those just getting started in the early divisions like tee ball, coach pitch, and farm.

My goal is to help ensure decisions reflect the needs of all families, while supporting a positive and inclusive environment where kids feel encouraged and excited to play.

Do you have any time constraints that would affect your ability to serve as a FOVLL Board member?
